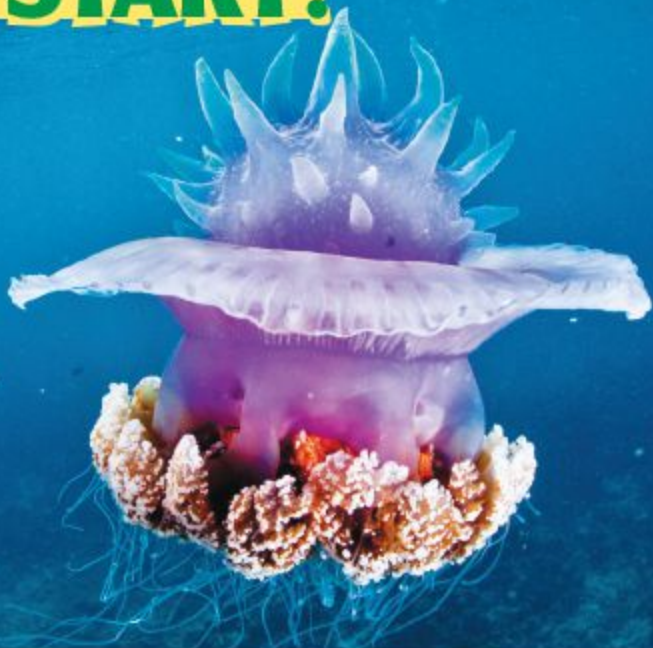

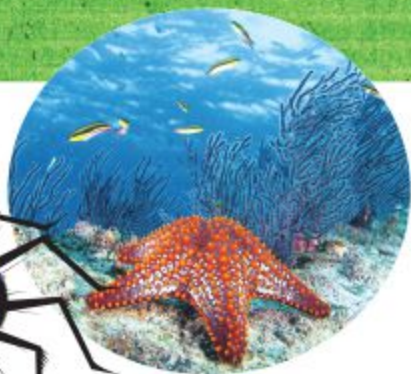
LET'S START!

LOOKING AT INVERTEBRATES
