Past time expressions

Floyd usually likes Binty and Fluffy, but right now he's not enjoying being with them. Yesterday Floyd was in the garden

with Fluffy and Binty.

A few hours ago Fluffy and Binty were Floyd's best friends.

Now they aren't!

Affirmative

you/we/they play he/she/it plays

Negative

don't play you/we/they don't play he/she/it doesn't play

Questions

Do | play?

Do you/we/they play? Does he/she/it play?

Short answers

Yes, | do. / No, | don't.

Yes, you/we/they do./No, you/we/they don't. Yes, he/she/it does./No, he/she/it doesn't.

Present continuous

Uses

- · things happening at the moment
- · things happening now
- · things happening these days

Affirmative I'm playing

you/we/they're playing he's/she's/it's playing

Negative

I'm not playing

he/she/it isn't playing

Questions

Am | playing?

Are you/we/they playing? Is he/she/it playing?

Short answers

Yes, | am. / No, |'m not.

you/we/they aren't playing Yes, you/we/they are./No, you/we/they aren't.

Yes, he/she/it is./No, he/she/it isn't.

I was He/She/It was ...

Affirmative

| was

you/we/they were he/she/it was

Negative

I was not / wasn't you/we/they were not/weren't he/she/it was not/wasn't

Questions

Was I?

Were you/we/they? Was he/she/it?

Short answers

Yes, I was./No, I wasn't. Yes, you/we/they were./ No, you/we/they weren't. Yes, he/she/it was./ No, he/she/it wasn't.
