leis – traditional Hawaiian flower
necklaces! Festivities last all day long,
including lei making demonstrations,
concerts and competitions! There is
also traditional Hawaiian food, music,
hula dancing and the crowning of a
Lei Day king and queen! The most
important part of the day, though,
is exchanging leis with family
and friends!

In France, the **lily of the valley** is

the traditional May Day flower.
People give each other this small
white flower on this special day. Streets
and homes are decorated with it and
some people fill small baskets with these
beautiful flowers and leave them on
other people's doorsteps!

Did you know?

One tradition
in Germany is to
decorate May trees! The
trees are usually decorated
with long, colourful ribbons
and flowers, and placed in the
centre of the town! People also
celebrate with parades and street
bands. In some towns, there is a
fun tradition of stealing the
May tree from a nearby
town!

May Day is

popular in Portugal. The day
before, people go to the countryside
to collect yellow broom flowers. They
place the flowers around the windows
and doors of their homes for
good luck. They even decorate
their cars with them!
