



1. In a cottage in a wood




This is a little cottage. It's in a little wood.

The old man is happy, too.


🎵 Let's sing! 🎵

His head goes RATTLE – RATTLE – RATTLE!




“Whoopee! Watch me steam up!” shouts Mr Teapot.
