



Animals use camouflage, too! They use colours, patterns or shapes.
These things help them hide.





COLOURS FOR HIDING

Some animals use colour to hide. This is called concealing coloration.

The arctic fox lives in a cold, snowy world. Look left. Everything is white! Look right. Everything is white! So the arctic fox is white, too!

The arctic fox uses concealing coloration. Its white fur is the same colour as the white snow. The arctic fox uses concealing coloration to catch its prey.
