# BONFIRE NIGHT

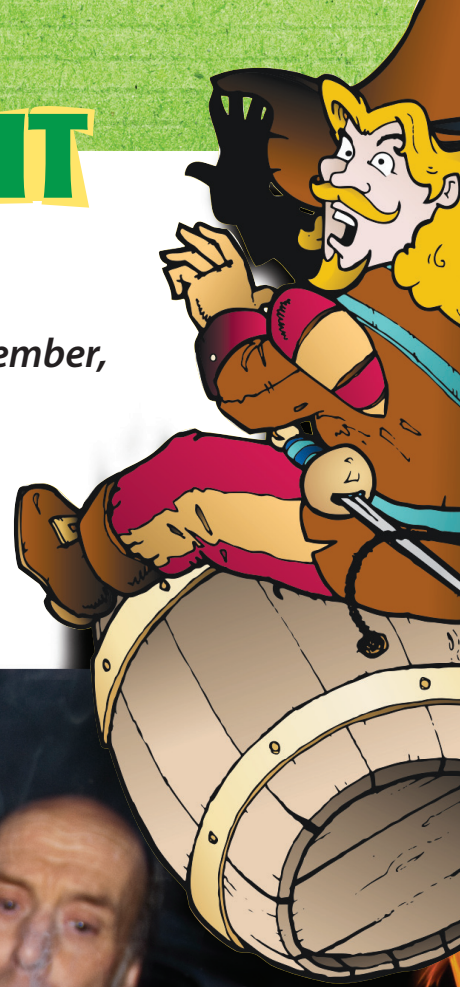


*Remember, remember the fifth of November,

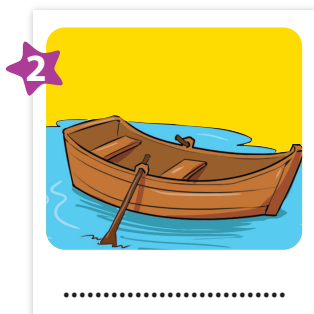

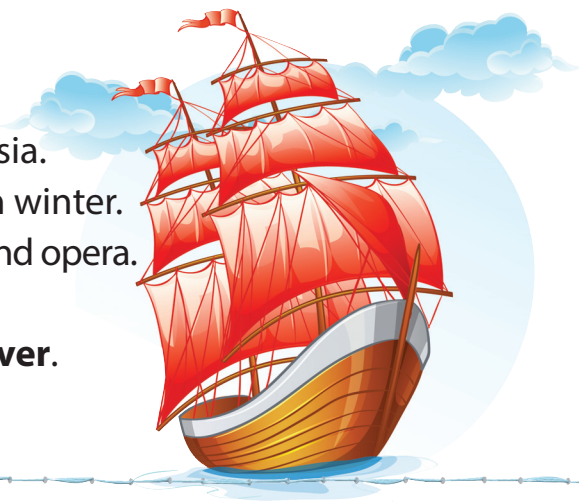
