

# going to (revision)

Do you remember? To talk about plans and intentions for the future we use **am / is / are + going to + base form of the verb**. We use **going to** also to say that something is about to happen.

I'm	<b>going to</b>	buy a new phone.
You're		like that video.
He's / She's / It's		go away.
We're		learn a new language.
You're		play together.
They're		get a dog.

## going to – negative

To make the negative form of **going to** use **'m not / isn't / aren't** + **going to** + base form of the verb.

I'm **not going to** help you.

You **aren't going to** like this.

He/She **isn't going to** watch TV all day.

It **isn't going to** rain tomorrow.

We **aren't going to** tell anybody.

They **aren't going to** play football this afternoon.
